Bulkley Landscape Reforestation Standards Project

Abstract:

The desire to link silviculture reforestation stocking standards to timber supply assumptions and to other related objectives at the *Landscape* level, has been discussed for more than a decade.

A recent paper from the Resource Practices Branch, FLNRO, the Bednesti Tour - Potential Action Points, Oct 2, 2014, states that there is a need to: Redesign Surveys and Monitoring as required to accurately reflect performance in relation to the refined Timber Objectives, and the data collected should be compatible with the information needs for (Timber Supply Reviews) TSR.

The survey and monitoring design needs to be in the context of assessing stocking standards and other related objectives at the <u>Landscape</u> level.

Pacific Inland Resources (PIR) intends to support this process by developing a Bulkley *Landscape* Reforestation Standards (B-LRS) project in collaboration with various government staff, to provide a different approach to collecting, storing recording, reporting silviculture survey field data. These standards will then be submitted to the Ministry as an amendment to the Stocking Standards of our Forest Stewardship Plan (FSP).
