

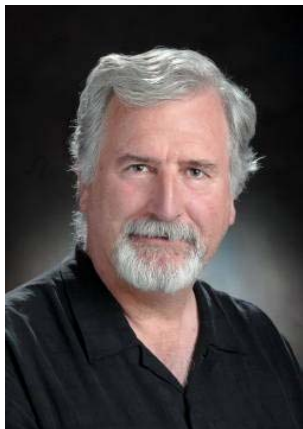


## Statistics Refresher for Resource Management Professionals
