Selection Criteria

- A volunteer member who has demonstrated extraordinary volunteer efforts towards a BVRC research project or operations (volunteer efforts are considered to be above and beyond one's own regular work schedules and parameters, and that have significant benefits to the BVRC and our community).
- A volunteer who is an active and involved member of the BVRC.

NOTE: The committee may choose not to designate a winner every year if, in its opinion, none of the nominations meet the standards expected of the award.

Anyone, including those whose contribution is to be recognized.
